- Remain fully compliant with legislative provisions in the field of SHE, and consider other requirements and recommendations that have been agreed to, as well as local specifics and conditions.
- Focus particular attention on education, training and health of personnel, rise awareness among employees about SHE issues in all company's operations, reduce injury risks or medical harm, damages of working equipment and other properties.
